• List out what is said about the wise person and what is said about the fool.

NOTE: Some verses don't explicitly say "wise" or "fool" but use a similar term.

EXAMPLE

<u>Pv. 13:5</u> *A righteous man <u>hates lying</u>, But a wicked man is <u>loathsome</u> and <u>comes to shame.</u>*

Righteous / Wise	Wicked / Foolish
Hates lying	Loathsome, comes to shame

Contrasts in Proverbs

<u>Pv. 3:35</u>	The wise shall inherit glory, But shame shall be the legacy of fools.
Pv. 10:3	The Lord will not allow the righteous soul to famish, But He casts away the desire of the wicked.
Pv. 10:8	The wise in heart will receive commands, but a prating fool will fall.
<u>Pv. 10:11</u>	The mouth of the righteous is a well of life, But violence covers the mouth of the wicked.
<u>Pv. 10:16</u>	The labor of the righteous leads to life, The wages of the wicked to sin.
<u>Pv. 10:25</u>	When the whirlwind passes by, the wicked is no more, But the righteous has an everlasting foundation.
<u>Pv. 11:18</u>	The wicked man does deceptive work, But he who sows righteousness will have a sure reward.
<u>Pv. 11:23</u>	The desire of the righteous is only good, But the expectation of the wicked is wrath.
Pv. 12:1	Whoever loves instruction loves knowledge, but he who hates correction is stupid.
Pv. 12:2	A good man obtains favor from the LORD, but a man of wicked intentions He will condemn.
<u>Pv. 12:12</u>	The wicked covet the catch of evil men, But the root of the righteous yields fruit.
<u>Pv. 14:1</u>	The wise woman builds her house, But the foolish pulls it down with her hands.
<u>Pv. 14:16</u>	A wise man fears and departs from evil, But a fool rages and is self-confident.
<u>Pv. 15:2</u>	The tongue of the wise uses knowledge rightly, But the mouth of fools pours forth foolishness.
<u>Pv. 21:15-26</u>	The desire of the lazy man kills him, for his hands refuse to labor.
	He covets greedily all day long, But the righteous gives and does not spare.
<u>Pv. 28:26</u>	He who trusts in his own heart is a fool, But whoever walks wisely will be delivered.
<u>Pv. 29:11</u>	A fool vents all his feelings, But a wise man holds them back.
