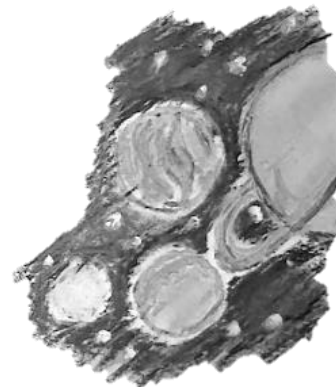
DIRECTIONS

▶ Think back on times when you have been truly in awe of God. Draw representations of the things that inspire that sense of wonder. Fill up the blank space with these images. Don't worry if you're not artistic. The purpose of this exercise is to spend time reflecting on how awe-inspiring God is and to remember times throughout your life where this fact has been especially evident to you.

IDEAS: Something you've observed in nature, an experience you've had, an act of God from the Bible, something God has done for you, etc.

TIP: Oil pastels provide vibrant color that won't bleed through the page. Use a cotton bud or finger to blend the color.
