Pv. 10:7	The memory of the righteous is blessed, But the name of the wicked will rot.
Pv. 10:17	He who keeps instruction is in the way of life, but he who refuses correction goes astray.
Pv. 10:32	The lips of the righteous know what is acceptable, But the mouth of the wicked what is perverse.
Pv. 12:5	The thoughts of the righteous are right, But the counsels of the wicked are deceitful.
Pv. 12:10	A righteous man regards the life of his animal, But the tender mercies of the wicked are cruel.
Pv. 12:13	The wicked is ensnared by the transgression of his lips, But the righteous will come through trouble.
Pv. 12:15	The way of a fool is right in his own eyes, But he who heeds counsel is wise.
Pv. 13:20	He who walks with wise men will be wise, But the companion of fools will be destroyed.
Pv. 13:5	A righteous man hates lying, But a wicked man is loathsome and comes to shame.
Pv. 14:32	The wicked is banished in his wickedness, But the righteous has a refuge in his death.
Pv. 15:5	A fool despises his father's instruction, But he who receives correction is prudent.
Pv. 15:14	The heart of him who has understanding seeks knowledge, But the mouth of fools feeds on foolishness.
Pv. 15:20	A wise son makes a father glad, But a foolish man despises his mother.
Pv. 15:28	The heart of the righteous studies how to answer, But the mouth of the wicked pours forth evil.
Pv. 15:29	The Lord is far from the wicked, But He hears the prayer of the righteous.
Pv. 28:1	The wicked flee when no one pursues, But the righteous are bold as a lion.
Pv. 29:7	The righteous considers the cause of the poor, But the wicked does not understand such knowledge.
